

Patients will be able to continue receiving care from PHS as long as we have a contract with their insurance provider, but we recognized that many families were unaware of the recommended age to begin planning for transition (as young as 12) and a lack of resources available to help them in this process. Bivona Trachs Restocked in Limited Quantities

HOW WE'RE TAKING ACTION

Smiths Medical informed PHS in March that sterilized Bivona trach tubes would be unavailable due to the closure of their sterilization company by the Environmental Protection Agency.

Although they are shipping on a strategic schedule, our supply is still limited as we work to restock to full capacity. We expect to be fully stocked by the end of May.

If you have a patient who receives Bivona trach tubes from PHS, it is possible we will need to obtain new patient orders for a similar product until we are fully stocked again.

We have updated all PHS patients who use Bivona trach tubes that they were unavailable.
