

## Lab specific:

- The doors of the lab will be locked at all times when not in use.
- Do not enter the simulation lab without a simulation team member.
- Do not remove any equipment or supplies from the lab without consent from a simulation team member.
- Do not use equipment in the lab for any purpose other than specified in the simulation.
- Do not move or adjust oximeter probes.
- No food or drink are allowed in the lab, except for prop purposes.
- Electronics, including cell phones, are not allowed in the lab as they may interfere with the simulators.
- Use of the computers is restricted to lab staff only - no personal use.

## Employee/student specific:

- Treat the simulators with respect and handle as if they are a live patient.
- Learners are to act as if they are in a real patient situation - keeping in mind safety, infection, and HIPAA regulations.
- Prior to attending simulation lab, learners will have reviewed the required resources and materials.
- Learners must act in a professional manner during prebrief, simulation, and debrief.
- Learners should dress in appropriate clinical attire for simulation.
- All participants are to wear their employee or school badge while in the lab.
- Learners are to remain confidential and professional regarding the performance of other learners during and after simulation experiences.
- Facilitators have the right to remove learners if conduct is violated.
- Due to the RF frequencies with the simulation equipment, please do not wear Fitbits, Apple watches, etc., or bring smartphones into the simulation lab.

## Simulator specific:

- There is no latex externally on the simulators. Learners should contact the lab coordinator with any known latex allergies.
- Do not use betadine, markers, or pens on the simulators.
- Gloves must be worn whenever working on a simulator.
