



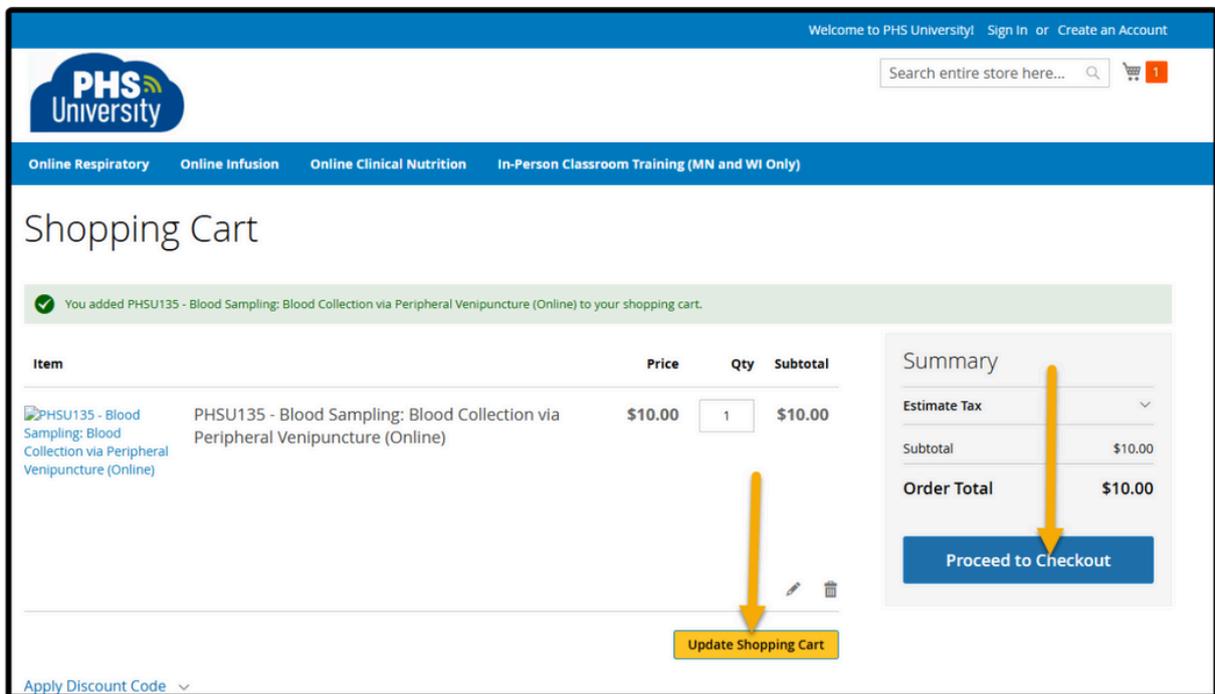
- If you are purchasing the course for another user, first click on the title of the course.



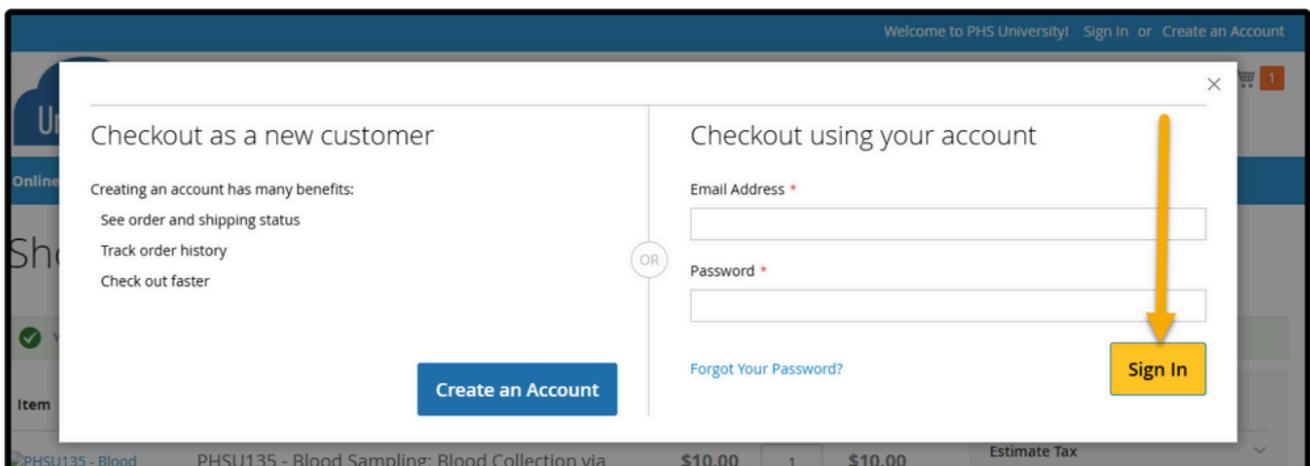
- It will default to purchasing for self. If purchasing for someone else, click that radio button and fill in the required information.




- Once you click Add to Cart it immediately takes you to your cart. You can either click 'Update Shopping List' and search for more courses or click 'Proceed to Checkout'.

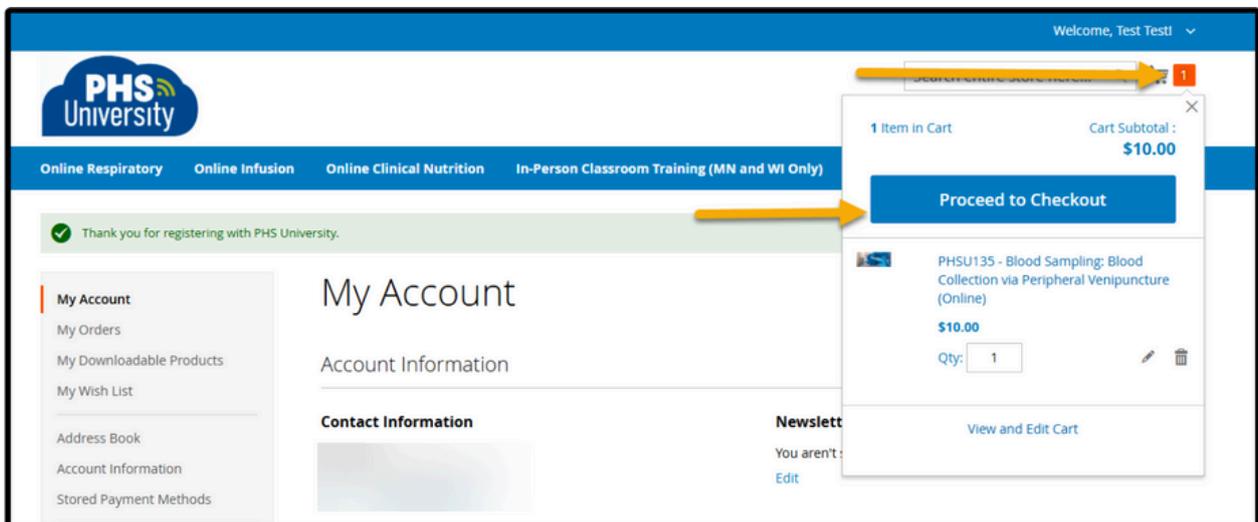
